

Danube Cycle Path Vienna - Bratislava

The Danube cycling path does not end in Vienna! East of Vienna begins the fascinating landscape of the Pannonian Lowlands. The wonderful "Donauauen" Nature Reserve is host to one of the last primeval forests in Europe. Furthermore, the Slovakian capital Bratislava enchants its guests with a lovely restored old city centre and numerous intriguing sights.

Tour profile: Level 1; Paths are paved and mostly flat. Upon entering and leaving cities there is, but of course, traffic that must be closely observed!

Accommodation:

4-star hotel in Bratislava or middle-range hotels

ITINERARY

1. Day: Vienna – Region Bad Deutsch Altenburg, approx. 46 km

The Danube cycling path leads you on peaceful path through the "Donauauen" National Park, passing the castles of "Orth" and "Eckartsau". Then reaching the former Roman city Petronell-Carnuntum (Roman excavations) and visiting the health resort Bad Deutsch Altenburg. The vineyards of Carnuntum offer you countless delights.

2. Day: Region Bad Deutsch Altenburg – Bratislava, approx. 21 km

After a short ride you reach the border city of Hainburg. Through an impressive Nature Reserve you then ride directly into the city of Bratislava.

3. Day: Bratislava - Vienna

Provided bus from Bratislava to Vienna. Option: hydrofoil boat ride (surcharge applies).
Duration: approx. 1:20 hr



GENERAL INFORMATION

All bike tours are unescorted. The mileages and approximations are distances of the recommended routes. Please be prepared by packing all necessary items, for example, proper rain gear (jacket and pants), sun hat, sunscreen and proper sport shoes. Arrival and departure to and from Vienna is a personal obligation not included in tour price.

Vienna – Bratislava approx. 75 km away from one another, Bus from Bratislava-Vienna (approx. 10 EUR) and Budapest-Vienna are both accessible by many "Low-cost-Airlines".

In Slovakia you must wear a helmet by law outside of city limits!

In Austria it is mandatory for children under 12 yrs to wear a helmet when on a bike.

PARKING

- ✓ Parking garage at the arrival hotel: approx. EUR 18,- per day, unguarded, locked
- ✓ Public parking places: unguarded, free of charge, directly behind the hotel
- ✓ Public parking garage = Park & Ride: approx. EUR 3,- per day, approx. 12,- EUR per week, unguarded, at the underground/metro station Leopoldau

INCLUDED SERVICES

- ✓ 2 nights in rooms with private facilities
- ✓ Breakfast or half board for an extra charge
- ✓ Daily luggage transfer up to hotel in Bratislava (1 suitcase/max. 20 kg/person)
- ✓ Return transfer by public bus from Bratislava to Vienna, departure at 2.00 p.m.
- ✓ Service-hotline (also accessible on weekends)
- ✓ Handlebar bag with maps and information material per room

RENTAL BIKES & EQUIPMENT

7-gear-UNISEX-touring bike with coaster brake (back pedal) or 21-gear-UNISEX-touring bike
Electric bikes, children's bikes and other specialized equipment for children upon request.
All rental bikes are equipped with a pannier (saddle bag) and an odometer.
